TUITION DISCOUNTS

1. Multiple siblings (excludes half-day Kindergarten)
 - a. There is a 20% discount on total tuition when 2 children are enrolled all day.
 - b. There is a 30% discount on total tuition when 3 children are enrolled all day.
 - c. The fourth child may attend FREE.
 - d. Parents who pay the entire amount of yearly tuition on or before September 1 qualify for the following discount:
 K-6 (\$50), 7-12 (\$100).

ADDITIONAL FEES

- * \$20 for all NSF (non-sufficient funds) checks
- * \$20 lab fee per semester for Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Keyboarding, Computer 9-12
- * \$50 Eighth Grade Graduation fee
- * \$125 Foreign Language fee
- * A \$15 late fee is charged for payments received after the 10th. If payment is not received within **thirty days** (15 days for the August and May payment), the student is not permitted to attend classes.
- * Before and after school care is also available
- * \$195 for instrumental private lessons per semester
- * \$35 for 7-12th Band/Handchimes per semester
- * \$20 for Elementary Band per semester
- * \$150 Senior High Graduation fee

HIGHLIGHTS OF TUITION AND FEES CHANGES FOR 2011-2012

RE-REGISTRATION FEE remains the same at \$50 per student, with a maximum of \$100 per family, and is available through April 30th. After April 30, the new registration fee of \$100 per student or \$200 per family applies.

MATERIAL AND ACTIVITY FEES are the slightly higher this year, reflecting higher costs charged by vendors. The material and activity fee covers the cost of the textbooks along with other items listed below. In addition, each family will receive one yearbook. Extra yearbooks may be purchased at an additional cost.

The fee for each sport covers the actual cost of that sport's referees, transportation to away games, uniform replacement every five years, and equipment replacement. The greater expense generated by the athletic program, including coaching salaries, tournament fees, gym and field maintenance, additional utilities, liability insurance, and vehicle insurance, is met primarily through the general tuition paid by all students.
